A parent or guardian is also required to sign and have their signature NOTARIZED on the International Border Crossing Parental Permission form below. Please send this form, with notarized signature, to the Rein Teen Tours office by June 1.

Passport information and applications are available at <http://www.usps.com/passport/>. This website will direct you to the Passport Processing Center closest to your home (most often a local post office). Routine processing time is 4-6 weeks.

Please remember to bring the passport on your first day – DO NOT SEND passports to our office. Our leaders will hold your passport during the summer and return it to you at the completion of the program.
