

To ensure a safe and successful experience, Rein Teen Tours forbids the following:

1. Possession or use of any illegal drug or drug paraphernalia
2. Possession or drinking of alcohol
3. Breaking curfew – leaving your room or tent after designated curfew
4. Disruptive or unsafe behavior
5. Breaking any municipal, state, or federal law

Violation of any of the above rules will result in a teenager's dismissal from the program. There will be no refund if a teenager is dismissed for a rules violation.

The Rein Teen Tours and Rein Community Service staff recognize the destructive impact bullying has on the emotional and psychological well-being of our children. Rein Teen Tours and Rein Community Service do not allow bullying in any form including verbal insults and intimidation, physical threats, inappropriate comments, pictures or messages via cellular text messaging or social networking applications such as Facebook. Rein Teen Tours reserves the right to dismiss a teenager from any program for bullying behavior.

The undersigned acknowledge that they have read and fully understand the above Rules, and the signing of the Agreement signifies their acceptance of the above Rules. Please understand that if a Teenager breaks the rules, that Teenager must accept responsibility for his or her actions. We respectfully ask that parents do not ask for a second chance for a teenager who has broken the rules. No excuses can be offered for breaking the above rules.
